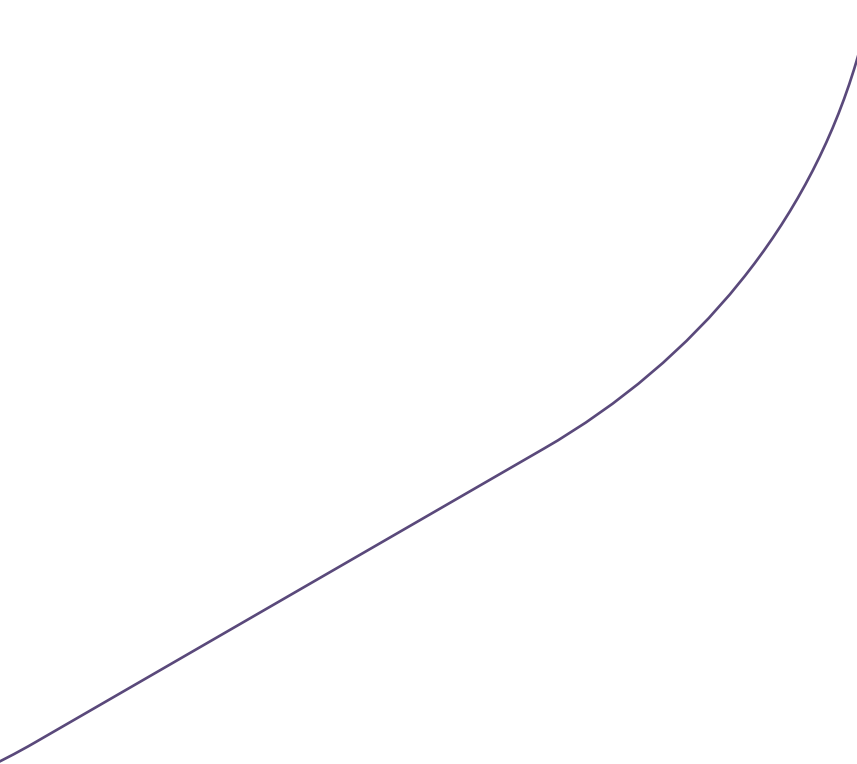
As we look ahead, I believe Foundever.org can play an increasingly important role for all of our stakeholders.

Founded on the belief that talent is universal but opportunity is not, Foundever.org works to help individuals and communities access the skills, knowledge, networks and support needed to thrive in an evolving world of work. Through partnerships with nonprofit organisations, educational institutions, volunteers and corporate partners, the foundation develops and supports programmes focused on employability, education, mentorship and future skills.

As a private operating foundation, Foundever.org was established to create impact beyond the scope of Foundever's day-to-day business activities while building on the expertise, capabilities and values that have shaped the company for more than three decades. At its core, the foundation seeks to connect talent with opportunity and contribute to a future where more people have access to meaningful employment, lifelong learning and economic inclusion.

Programmes are selected based on their alignment with the foundation's mission, potential for sustainable outcomes and ability to expand access to opportunity for underserved populations.

Foundever.org is committed to responsible governance, transparent reporting and continuous evaluation of programme outcomes to ensure that resources are directed toward initiatives capable of delivering lasting social impact.

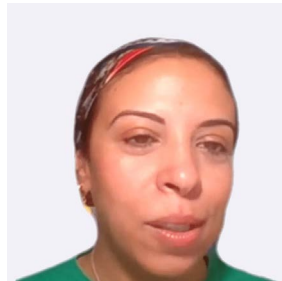

Freelance Mama - Egypt

Empowering women through skills, confidence and economic opportunity

The Challenge

Across Egypt, many women - particularly mothers - face significant barriers to entering or re-entering the workforce. Family responsibilities, limited access to flexible employment opportunities and gaps in digital skills often prevent talented women from achieving economic independence.

At the same time, the growth of the digital economy is creating new opportunities for remote work, freelancing and entrepreneurship. However, access to the skills required to participate in these opportunities remains uneven.

Why it matters

At Foundever.org, we believe that empowering women creates a multiplier effect that benefits families, communities and local economies.

Freelance Mama helps women access opportunities that fit their circumstances while developing skills that remain relevant in an increasingly digital world.

Programme Model

Freelance Mama was developed in partnership with Carerha, one of the leading women-focused education platforms in the Middle East and North Africa.

The programme provides women with practical training in areas such as digital skills, content creation, community management, graphic design and freelancing. Participants also receive career guidance and support designed to help them access income-generating opportunities and build greater confidence in their professional capabilities.

The programme combines technical training with personal development, creating a pathway towards greater economic resilience and independence.

2025 Results

In 2025, Freelance Mama continued to expand its impact in Egypt, supporting women as they developed new skills and explored new pathways to employment and entrepreneurship.

The programme achieved strong participant satisfaction and employability outcomes, demonstrating the value of combining practical training with personalised support.

Participant Story

For years, Nourhan balanced the demands of motherhood while putting her own professional aspirations on hold. Before becoming a mother of two, she had built a career in marketing and customer service, but like many women, family responsibilities led her to step away from the workforce. When the time came to consider her next chapter, she was looking for more than a job opportunity. She was looking for a way to reconnect with herself. That opportunity came through Freelance Mama, the women's empowerment programme delivered by Foundever.org and Carerha in Egypt.

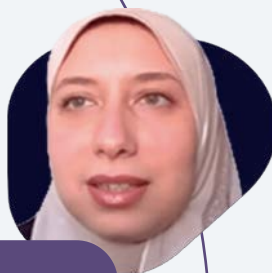
Drawn to the Graphic Design track, Nourhan discovered a space where she could combine learning with a long-standing passion for creativity. Since childhood, she had loved painting, drawing and experimenting with colours. Through the programme, she learned design principles, digital tools and visual storytelling techniques, while gaining practical skills that could help her build a freelance career.

The experience went far beyond technical training. Nourhan developed greater confidence in her abilities, learned how to manage her time effectively, navigate client relationships, search for opportunities and strengthen her professional presence online.

Perhaps most importantly, the programme helped her rediscover a sense of possibility. Inspired by her learning journey, Nourhan has since developed an interest in animation, combining skills acquired through Freelance Mama with another passion she shares with her children: watching cartoons together.

Today, Nourhan sees herself not only as a mother, but also as a creative professional with new ambitions and renewed confidence.

"Freelance Mama reminded me that I am capable of learning new skills, pursuing my passions and building a future on my own terms. It gave me the confidence to believe that I can do anything."

Partner Perspective

One of the reasons Freelance Mama has been so successful is that it was designed around the realities many women face. Many participants are highly educated but have stepped away from the workforce due to caregiving responsibilities or other life circumstances. Traditional employment pathways are often difficult to access, creating a gap between talent and opportunity.

"Freelance Mama demonstrates what can happen when skills development, confidence-building and practical career support come together. These women already have the potential. What they need is access, guidance and opportunities."

Through the partnership between Foundever.org and Carerha, participants receive more than technical training. They gain mentoring, career coaching, professional networks and exposure to flexible work opportunities aligned with today's digital economy.

"In 2025, we saw women not only complete the program but actively apply their new skills, launch freelance activities and rebuild their professional confidence. The impact extends beyond the individual participant. It strengthens families, communities and local economies."

Connecting Talent with Opportunity

The Challenge

Many students and early-career professionals possess the ambition and potential to succeed but lack access to professional networks, career guidance and experienced mentors who can help them navigate important decisions.

Mentorship helps bridge this gap by providing practical advice, confidence and exposure to real-world professional experiences.

Programme Model

Through Foundever.org's partnership with the Global Mentorship Initiative (GMI), Foundever associates volunteer as mentors, supporting students and young professionals through structured one-to-one mentoring relationships.

The programme creates meaningful connections between experienced professionals and emerging talent, helping participants develop career readiness, confidence and professional skills.

Why it matters

A single mentoring relationship can have a lasting impact on a person's educational and professional journey.

By sharing knowledge, experience and encouragement, mentors help participants expand their horizons and access opportunities that might otherwise remain out of reach.

Mentor Growth

The mentor community continued to grow significantly throughout 2025, reflecting strong employee engagement and increasing interest in skills-based volunteering.

Student Growth

The programme supported students from multiple countries and educational backgrounds, creating opportunities for learning, networking and professional development.

Volunteer Engagement

The Global Mentorship Initiative remains Foundever.org's flagship employee volunteering programme and one of the clearest examples of how professional expertise can be transformed into social impact.

Success Story

Mentorship in Action - Building Confidence, Creating Opportunities

One of the most powerful examples of the Global Mentorship Initiative is the story of Destin, a student from Côte d'Ivoire who aspired to build a career in technology.

Although he had a strong academic background and a clear vision for the future, Destin faced a challenge familiar to many young professionals: translating ambition into a realistic career path. Through the Global Mentorship Initiative, he was matched with Guillaume Barry, an IT manager at Foundever.

Over twelve weeks, mentor and mentee worked together on career planning, professional positioning, networking and confidence-building. Guillaume helped Destin recognise that his previous studies and experiences were not obstacles to a career in technology, but valuable assets that could help him stand out.

The mentorship relationship provided practical guidance, but also something equally important: belief. Through regular conversations, feedback and encouragement, Destin gained greater confidence in his abilities and developed a clearer roadmap for his future.

Today, he continues to pursue opportunities in the technology sector with a stronger sense of direction and purpose.

Their story demonstrates what mentorship can achieve when professional expertise meets genuine commitment. It is not simply about sharing knowledge. It is about helping someone see possibilities they may not yet see for themselves.

Mentor Spotlight

For David Poncin, Finance Director at Foundever, mentoring is about creating opportunities for others while continuing to learn himself.

Having built a successful international career in finance, David understands how valuable guidance can be during the early stages of a professional journey. Through the Global Mentorship Initiative, he volunteers his time to support students as they navigate career decisions, strengthen their professional profiles and prepare for the realities of the job market.

What motivates him most is seeing mentees gain confidence and discover their own potential. While sharing professional expertise is important, David believes effective mentoring is equally about listening, understanding individual aspirations and helping students identify practical steps towards their goals.

The experience has also been rewarding on a personal level. Through conversations with students from different countries and backgrounds, David has gained fresh perspectives and insights into the challenges and opportunities facing the next generation of professionals.

"Mentoring is not only about giving back. It is also an opportunity to learn, broaden your perspective and connect with talented young people who will shape the future."

Like many Foundever mentors, David demonstrates that mentorship is a two-way exchange, creating value for both mentor and mentee while strengthening a culture of learning and inclusion.

Student Spotlight

Marwa, a Human Resources Management master's student from Morocco, joined the Global Mentorship Initiative with strong academic credentials but limited experience navigating the professional job market.

Like many students approaching graduation, she knew her subject matter well but was less confident about how to present herself to employers. Through the programme, she was matched with Coline, a mentor from Foundever who helped her strengthen key employability skills.

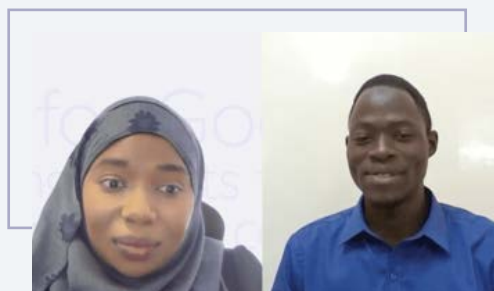
Together, they worked on refining her CV, improving her professional profile and preparing for future job opportunities. Coline also leveraged her professional network to gather additional feedback and ensure Marwa's application materials reflected her full potential.

The experience helped Marwa move beyond academic achievement and develop greater confidence in her ability to compete in a professional environment.

"The mentorship programme gave me practical guidance that I could immediately apply. It helped me understand not only how to look for opportunities, but also how to communicate my strengths with confidence."

Marwa's journey reflects the broader purpose of the programme: helping talented young people bridge the gap between education and employment through mentorship, guidance and access to professional networks.

Women & Girls



Inspiring Girls (Portugal and Spain)
Expanding Horizons and Challenging Stereotypes

The Challenge

Many girls continue to face barriers when imagining their future careers. Limited exposure to diverse role models and professional pathways can affect aspirations, confidence and career choices from an early age.

Creating opportunities for girls to meet women from different industries helps broaden perspectives and challenge stereotypes about what is possible.

Programme Model

Through its partnership with Inspiring Girls, Foundever.org connects girls with female role models who share their experiences, career journeys and lessons learned.

Sessions focus on confidence building, aspiration raising and helping young people understand the opportunities available to them in an evolving world of work.

Why it matters

Representation matters.

When girls see women succeeding in different careers and leadership roles, they are more likely to believe that similar opportunities are available to them.

Volunteer Participation

Foundever associates participated as speakers, role models and programme ambassadors, sharing their experiences and encouraging girls to pursue their ambitions.

Stories

Participant: Sofia

Before participating in an Inspiring Futures workshop, Sofia had never considered that a career in technology could be for someone like her.

Like many young people, she had ideas about what she enjoyed at school but little exposure to the wide range of careers that exist beyond the professions she saw around her every day. Technology, artificial intelligence and digital careers felt distant and difficult to imagine.

Seeing new possibilities

Through the Inspiring Futures programme, delivered by Foundever.org and Inspiring Girls, Sofia took part in an interactive workshop exploring AI, digital skills and future career opportunities. Most importantly, she met professional women who shared their own career journeys, challenges and achievements.

Hearing directly from role models helped her understand that successful careers are rarely linear and that skills such as curiosity, resilience and continuous

learning are just as important as technical expertise.

The experience changed how she thought about her future. Rather than focusing on what she could not do, she began exploring what she could become.

"The workshop showed me careers I didn't even know existed. Listening to women working in technology made me believe that I could follow a similar path one day."

Today, Sofia approaches her studies with greater confidence and a broader understanding of the opportunities available to her. Her story reflects the programme's mission: helping young people see possibilities that stereotypes and limited exposure often hide.

Volunteer: Carmen Carmona

When Carmen Carmona volunteered for Inspiring Futures, she expected to share her professional experience. What she did not expect was how much she would learn from the students themselves.

As a Foundever volunteer role model, Carmen participated in workshops designed to help young people explore future careers, strengthen digital confidence and better understand how technology is shaping the world of work. Alongside other volunteers, she shared her personal journey, including the challenges, doubts and lessons that shaped her career.

The power of showing up

What struck her most was the curiosity and openness of the students.

Their questions about technology, artificial intelligence, work and personal growth revealed a generation eager to learn but often lacking access to role models who could help them imagine different futures.

For Carmen, volunteering was a reminder that representation matters.

Sometimes a single conversation can help a young person see a new possibility for themselves.

"Many students told us they had never met someone working in a global company before. It reminded me that simply sharing our experiences can have a powerful impact on how young people view their own potential."

Through volunteers like Carmen, Inspiring Futures transforms professional experience into inspiration, helping young people connect ambition with opportunity while creating meaningful engagement opportunities for Foundever associates.

Refugee Programme with the United Nations (Brazil)
Supporting Inclusion Through Skills and Opportunity

The Challenge

Refugees and migrants often face significant barriers when rebuilding their lives in a new country.

Language barriers, limited professional networks, unfamiliar labour markets and social exclusion can make access to employment and economic participation particularly challenging.

Programme Model

The Refugee Programme in Brazil supports refugees and migrants through education, skills development and integration initiatives designed to strengthen employability and economic inclusion.

Working alongside specialised local partners, the programme provides practical support that helps participants develop confidence, improve workplace readiness and navigate opportunities within their new communities.

Why it matters

Economic inclusion is a critical step towards social inclusion.

By helping refugees access skills, networks and opportunities, the programme contributes to greater independence, resilience and long-term integration.

Looking Ahead

Building on the programme's success, Foundever.org aims to expand support for refugees and migrants in Brazil while exploring additional opportunities to promote inclusion and employability.

Stories of Impact

Building a new future, one opportunity at a time

When Richeily Hernandez arrived in Brazil from Venezuela in 2018, she faced many of the challenges common to people forced to leave their home countries: adapting to a new language, rebuilding a professional network and starting over in an unfamiliar environment.

Despite holding a degree in Business Administration and having previous banking experience, finding a pathway back into a professional career was not easy. Determined to create a better future, she took on different jobs while learning Portuguese and adapting to life in Brazil.

In 2019, Richeily joined Foundever. What began as an opportunity to re-enter the workforce soon became a platform for growth and development. Starting as a research analyst, she quickly demonstrated her capabilities and was promoted to supervisor, a role she has held successfully for several years.

For Richeily, the experience was about more than employment. It was about belonging.

"Foundever was my first formal job in Brazil and also the place where I truly felt welcomed. Having a job was important, but having the opportunity to grow made all the difference."

Today, she continues to invest in her personal and professional development, studying English with the goal of becoming trilingual and progressing further in her career.

Richeily's story reflects the transformative power of inclusion. With access to opportunity, support and a welcoming environment, people forced to rebuild their lives can thrive, contribute and create new futures for themselves and their families.

Partner Perspective

Creating opportunities through partnership

For more than a decade, Foundever has worked alongside the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR/ACNUR) and local partners to create pathways to employment for people in situations of forced displacement.

This collaboration goes beyond recruitment. Together, the partners help connect refugees with meaningful employment opportunities, facilitate access to training and development, and support their integration into the workplace and broader community.

As refugee populations continue to grow globally, employment remains one of the most effective ways to support long-term integration, independence and dignity.

“Access to decent work is a critical step in helping refugees rebuild their lives and contribute to their host communities. Partnerships with employers like Foundever demonstrate how the private sector can play a meaningful role in creating opportunities and fostering inclusion.”, said Laurent Delache, country director of Foundever in Brazil.

Through this partnership, Foundever has already supported more than 2,000 refugees and migrants in Brazil and has committed to reaching 1,000 refugee and migrant associate by 2027. The programme demonstrates how collaboration between businesses, international organisations and local stakeholders can generate lasting social and economic impact

By combining employment opportunities with training, language support, cultural integration and ongoing development, the initiative helps transform inclusion from an aspiration into a reality.





Volunteerism

The Power of Employee Volunteering

At Foundever.org, impact is not created through funding alone. One of the foundation's greatest strengths is the willingness of Foundever associates to share their time, knowledge and experience with others. Global Mentorship Initiative

The Global Mentorship Initiative remained the foundation's largest employee volunteering programme.

Mentors from across Foundever supported students and early-career professionals through one-to-one mentoring relationships, helping them navigate educational and professional challenges while building confidence and career readiness.

Inspiring Girls

Associates participated as role models and speakers, sharing their personal and professional journeys with girls and young women and encouraging them to explore future opportunities without limitations.

Community Engagement

Associates also supported local initiatives through volunteering activities, awareness campaigns and programme advocacy, helping strengthen connections between Foundever, nonprofit partners and local communities.

Building the Next Chapter of Foundever.org

The year 2025 demonstrated the potential of Foundever.org to create meaningful impact through education, mentorship, employability and future skills initiatives. It also confirmed the value of bringing together associates, nonprofit organisations, clients and communities around a shared purpose: creating pathways to opportunity.

As we look ahead to 2026, our focus shifts from building foundations to scaling impact. We will be dedicated to strengthening the operating model of Foundever.org, expanding its reach, deepening stakeholder engagement and establishing the foundation as a recognised contributor to Foundever's people, client and ESG strategy. While our mission remains unchanged, our ambition is growing.

Our goal is to reach more than 3,000 direct participants in 2026, representing a significant step towards our long-term ambition of impacting 10,000 lives by 2028.

Our Priorities for 2026

Consolidate and Strengthen Our Impact

Following the expansion of programmes and partnerships during 2025, our priority is to consolidate these efforts into a more structured, credible and visible platform. We will continue strengthening governance, impact measurement and reporting processes to ensure that our programmes deliver measurable outcomes and create long-term value for participants, partners and stakeholders. Through stronger storytelling and greater visibility, we will reinforce trust and demonstrate the role Foundever.org plays in extending Foundever's purpose beyond its business operations.

Make Employee Engagement a Strategic Lever

One of the most encouraging developments in 2025 was the enthusiasm shown by Foundever associates through mentoring, volunteering and advocacy. In 2026, we will further integrate social impact into the employee experience by creating more opportunities for associates to contribute their expertise, support local initiatives and participate in programmes aligned with their skills and interests.

Our objective is not only to increase participation but also to create meaningful experiences that foster pride, belonging, development and long-term engagement.

Deepen Client Partnerships

Social impact is increasingly becoming a priority for many of our clients. In 2026, Foundever.org will continue to develop and scale programmes co-created with clients, enabling them to engage in meaningful initiatives aligned with their ESG and sustainability goals while addressing real needs in the communities where we operate.

By creating shared-value partnerships, we aim to strengthen client relationships, enhance differentiation and demonstrate how business and social impact can work together to create positive outcomes.

Strengthen ESG Alignment and Impact Measurement

As reporting expectations continue to evolve, robust measurement and transparency are becoming increasingly important. During 2026, Foundever.org will further develop its impact measurement framework, introducing consistent metrics across programmes and expanding its reporting capabilities. This will support data-driven decision-making, strengthen stakeholder confidence and contribute to Foundever's broader ESG commitments.

Our ambition is to ensure that every programme can demonstrate not only its reach, but also its outcomes and long-term impact.

Programme Expansion in 2026

Building on the programmes launched and strengthened in 2025, Foundever.org plans to expand its portfolio across multiple geographies.

Key priorities include:

- ✓ Expanding **Freelance Mama** in Egypt to support more women in building skills and pathways to economic participation.
- ✓ Launching the **Pathways programme** in the Philippines, creating opportunities for underserved young adults to strengthen their employability and access the digital economy.
- ✓ Growing the **Global Mentorship Initiative**, with a target of reaching 250 mentors globally.
- ✓ Developing **new initiatives in strategic markets** including the United States, India and Latin America.
- ✓ Launching and scaling the **Business Mama** initiative in Morocco, empowering women and young adults through digital, entrepreneurial and future-focused skills development.
- ✓ Launching an **upskilling and employability programme** in South Africa, focused on increasing access to skills, innovation and income-generating opportunities for youth and women.
- ✓ Expanding the **Inspiring Girls** partnership across multiple countries, helping young girls develop confidence, aspirations and awareness of future career opportunities.
- ✓ Strengthening **collaborations with clients** to develop co-created education and employability programmes.

Foundever.org was created with a long-term vision: to help people access the skills, networks and opportunities they need to thrive in a changing world.

As technology transforms industries and the future of work continues to evolve, access to education, mentorship and employability support will become even more important. Appendix

Methodology

Impact Measurement Approach

- Foundever.org measures impact through a combination of quantitative and qualitative indicators designed to assess the reach, outcomes and engagement generated by its programmes.
- Data is collected through programme partners, participant surveys, attendance records, mentoring platforms, volunteer reporting and programme evaluations. Where applicable, information is verified through partner reports and supporting documentation.
- To ensure consistency across programmes, impact is assessed through three primary dimensions:

Reach

- Measures the scale of programme delivery and participation.
- Examples include:
 - o Number of participants
 - o Number of graduates
 - o Number of mentors
 - o Number of volunteers
 - o Number of training or mentoring hours delivered
 - o Number of countries reached

Outcomes

- Measures the changes experienced by participants as a result of programme participation.
- Examples include:
 - o Employability outcomes
 - o Skills acquisition
 - o Completion rates
 - o Confidence and career readiness indicators
 - o Progression into employment, education or entrepreneurship

Engagement

- Measures the contribution and involvement of stakeholders.
- Examples include:
 - o Volunteer participation
 - o Mentor engagement
 - o Employee involvement
 - o Client participation
 - o Partner collaboration

Reporting Period

- This report covers activities delivered between 1 January 2025 and 31 December 2025.
- Unless otherwise stated, all participant figures represent unique individuals directly reached through Foundever.org-supported programmes during the reporting period.

Data Limitations

As Foundever.org continues to strengthen its monitoring and evaluation framework, some programmes may use different methodologies or reporting frequencies. Efforts are underway to establish a consistent impact measurement framework across all programmes and geographies, supporting greater comparability, transparency and alignment with emerging ESG reporting requirements.

Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)

Foundever.org contributes to several of the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals through programmes focused on education, employability, digital inclusion, mentorship and economic empowerment.
